If you accept our offer for the diversion, the actual amount deposited for the appraisal will be deducted from the further deposit required on acceptance of the offer letter cost. A larger deposit may be required for complex diversions and we will advise you if this is the case on receipt and assessment of your application.

Any involvement of our networks staff in attending site, should this prove necessary, will be charged separately, as incurred, although this is not anticipated.
